The Coimín Centre, Blessington opened its doors on Thursday 19th March 2015. It houses the Parish Office and Day Care facility for the elderly. We also have rooms to rent by day / evening for local groups/organisations. This is a modern, attractive and convenient venue and offers the possibility for a wide variety of meetings, gatherings and events.

You may also be interested in rooms to rent in a more traditional setting. St Joseph's Hall, Blessinton has been at the heart of Blessington social and community life for many years, and today continues to be a thriving hub of activity for users of all ages. The Hall has been extensively refurbished in recent times and is in excellent condition throughout.

Both venues are serviced by Caretakers who are available to facilitate access to venues and to assist with particular user requirements.

All groups or organisations using the Coimín Centre and St Joseph's Hall must provide an up-to-date copy of their Insurance cover.




### Oak Room
